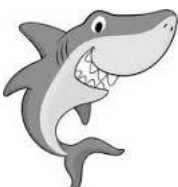

Transgender Bathrooms

Who are we talking about?

Do you know what "transgender" means? Well, you might think you know what it is, but it goes a little deeper than that. So you have a little better insight in what the next part of the article is actually trying to say, we wanted a definition that didn't just come from Google. Therefore, we decided to go to a health teacher at TAG for information. You might know her as your Physical Education teacher... Ms. Smith!

Ms. Smith said that "gender" works on a spectrum. People identify and express themselves in many different ways. This idea is also applied to transgender individuals, but the basic concept works like this: A person is born and assigned a particular "sex" - either male or female. Then, as they start to get a sense of themselves, they internally identify as a gender and in this case that might mean the opposite sex/gender. They may express that internal feeling through the clothes they wear, or the words and gestures they use. But, do not get that mixed-up with a sexual orientation. Sexual orientation is the gender you are attracted to whether or not you identify as being heterosexual, homosexual, or bisexual.

Why are we talking about it?

The Trump administration is ending the protection that was given by former president Barack Obama who said that all students can use the bathrooms matching the gender they currently identify with - not necessarily the one they were assigned at birth. Due to President Trump's order, however, transgender people will lose this protection or support from the federal government to be able to use the bathroom of their choice. For example, the person who was born as male but identifies as female, cannot use the girls bathroom. This will not affect public schools immediately. The piece put in place by the Obama administration is only blocked temporarily.

A major issue that is affecting many transgender people is that they don't feel safe. 150,000 Americans between the ages of 13-17 identify as transgender. According to the study by the UCLA school of law. This is resulting in many attempts in suicide and avoiding school. This is the result Donald Trump's executive decision lifting the transgender bathrooms.

- **75.1% of transgender students feel unsafe at school because of their gender expression.**
- **63% of transgender students reported not using bathrooms**
- **41% of transgender or gender non-conforming people have attempted suicide**

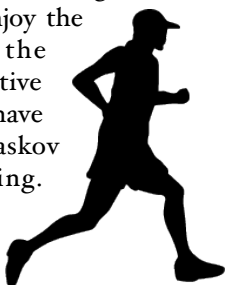

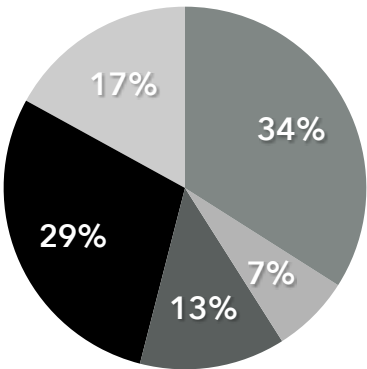
Careers at TAG

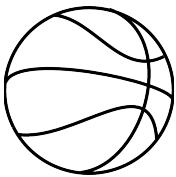
NBA Team of the Moment

Is Disney World Really Dismay World?

Several people have died or have been injured while riding attractions at Walt Disney World theme parks. For example, from the first quarter of 2005 to the first quarter of 2006, Disney reported four deaths and nineteen injuries at its Florida parks. Do you know these rides? And would you consider riding them after these deaths?

In splash world On November 5, 2000, a 37-year-old man from St. Petersburg, Florida, was critically injured while trying to exit the ride vehicle while it was moving. He told fellow passengers that he felt ill and attempted to reach one of the attraction's marked emergency exits. He was struck by the following ride vehicle and died at a local hospital.

What about It's a Small World? On August 18, 1994, a 6-year-old girl from Miami, Florida, fell out of one of the ride's boats while it was in the loading area. Orange County authorities believe she was then struck by an incoming boat. The girl suffered a broken hip, a broken arm and a collapsed lung, but was expected to recover fully. The ride was closed for an inspection and re-opened the following day.

Do you know Indiana Jones, what about Harrison Ford? The main character of Indiana Jones. Well this ride in Disney World were very fatal to multiple people. In one incident, a performer fell 30 feet when a restraining cable failed. A performer fell 25 feet when a prop ladder collapsed unexpectedly. A third performer was pinned by a malfunctioning trap door. At the time, OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration)cited Disney for failing to provide adequate fall protection, including padding and other equipment. Later, while rehearsing a new, safer routine, another performer fell 25 feet onto concrete. In a rehearsal on August 17, 2009, 30-year-old performer Anislav Varbanov died after injuring his head while performing a tumbling roll. Performances for the next day were canceled out of respect for Varbanov.

All these were due to malfunctions in the mechanical work, is DisneyWorld really a place you would like to visit? Notice these aren't all the deaths that happened. Many, many, many, MANY more happened in DisneyWorld. "World best place to visit"? I think not! Well that is just my opinion maybe not yours and you will still go visit, that's ok with me. But I really think that's not the best place in the world.

- Negligence on the part of the park, either by ride operator or maintenance.
- Caused by negligence on the part of the guest. This can be refusal to follow specific ride safety instructions, or deliberate intent to break park rules.
- The result of a guest's known or unknown health issues.
- Act of God or a generic accident (e.g. slipping and falling) that is not a direct result of an action on anyone's part. Etc

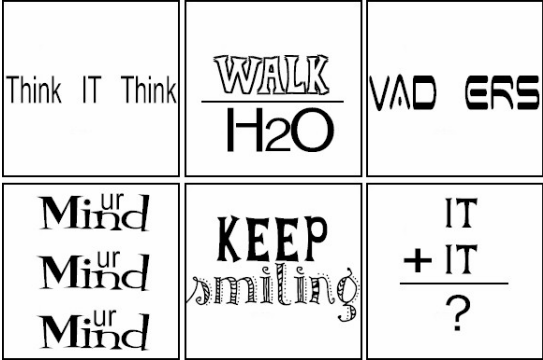
Ronaldo's Weakness's: On occasion, he goes to ground far too easily which attracts the fire of supporters tries a trick when a simple pass will do.
